

Scholarship Application Regulations, Department of Medicinal and Applied Chemistry

- I. Applicant eligibility for the department's scholarship for academic excellence:
1. First, second, and third year PhD students and first, and second year Master's students are eligible for application.
 2. Master's / PhD students in their first semester shall not apply for the scholarship, with the exception of students enrolled in the 5-year Master's program or 5-year PhD direct-entry program.

- II. The points listed below shall take priority in numerical order in the review process:
1. For Master's and PhD students: article publications, seminar posters, and oral presentations are taken into consideration in the grading process in the following manners:

(1) Article publications:

	Non-SCI journals	SCI journals
As the first author or corresponding author	+ 10 points	+ 30 points
As the second author	+ 7 points	+ 21 points
As the third author	+ 5 points	+ 15 points
As the fourth author	+ 3 points	+ 9 points
As the fifth author or later	+ 1 point	+ 3 points

(2) Seminar posters:

As the first author or corresponding author	+ 5 points
As the second author	+ 3 points
As the third author or later	+ 1 point

(3) Oral presentations:

English presentations	+ 10 points
Mandarin presentations	+ 7 points

If the student is awarded on the aforementioned occasions, they will receive a maximum of 10 points.

2. Should there be applicants in the same system with the same points, or should none of the

applicants boast journal publications, seminar posters, or oral presentations, their non-weighted grades from the previous semester shall account for their scores, with 50% being the average grade of the required courses, and the other 50% being the average grade of all courses, excluding zero-credit courses.

III. Criteria for journal publications, seminar posters, and oral presentations submitted for application:

1. The applicant should be a 5-year Master's program/Master's/PhD student from our department, and our department should be listed as an affiliation.
2. You shall not submit journal publications, seminar posters, and oral presentations already rewarded with scholarships for academic excellence.
3. An official letter of acceptance should be enclosed with journals that are accepted but yet to be published.
